



**Itinerary**  
**day trip Fish River Canyon & Lüderitz Namibia**  
**2020 / 2021**

Your pilot will be waiting for you in the terminal of the City Airport Windhoek / Eros. After a short welcome, you will depart to the south of Namibia. Across the Auas Mountains you will fly south past Rehoboth. You will pass the town of Mariental on your left and later you will also see the Brukkaros volcano.

After passing the main road between Keetmanshoop and Lüderitz, your pilot will initiate the descent to the Fish River Canyon. After about 2 hours flying time you will fly over the second largest canyon of the earth in its entire length, from north to south. This fascinating spectacle of nature can be easily observed and photographed from the air.



After the canyon has passed, the flight route continues to Lüderitz. Over the Huib plateau you will fly over the southern Namib desert and over the diamond restricted area, where entry is strictly prohibited. After another hour you will have reached Lüderitz.

Arrival time about 10:00 a.m. Here you will already be expected by your driver, who will drive you to Kolmannskuppe. The driving time will be approx. 5 minutes. At 11:00 a.m. you will be able to take a guided tour of this remarkable museum.





The duration of the tour is about 45 minutes. Afterwards, you will have the opportunity to walk around in the small village and look for photo opportunities. At about 12:30 a.m. you will leave the ghost town and will be driven by your driver into the city. In a restaurant you will have the opportunity to have a light lunch (optional), followed by a city tour through the small town of Lüderitz.

After the city tour, you will be driven to the city's airport. From here you fly back to Windhoek. After takeoff, we will fly past the town and follow the shoreline for about 30 minutes. At the picturesque rock "Sylvia Hill" we will leave the coast and fly to the dunes of Sossusvlei. Here you will be able to admire the highest dunes of the earth from a bird's-eye view.



The further flight route leads you past Solitaire and back to Windhoek. The flight time will be about 2 hours. Your estimated arrival time in Windhoek will be at 5:00 p.m.
